

The Priory Church of the Holy Trinity, Micklegate Weekly Pew Sheet (6-12 September)

All are welcome to attend in person. However, if you are unable to come in person you can still join in by telephone or internet.

- For the time being, a one-way system will be in operation when the church building is open.
 - Entrance: from Micklegate through the churchyard
 - Exit: through the West Door onto Priory Street
- In line with government guidance, we require all visitors (unless exempt) to wear face coverings during worship or while visiting for private prayer and sightseeing.
- There are hand sanitiser points for public use at the entry and exist – please do make use of these as you enter and leave the church.
- NHS Test and Trace: Holy Trinity has now been asked to take your contact details when you attend for worship. This will only be used if there is a need to contact you due to the Test & Trace programme. Consent forms are available at the entrance and can be deposited in the donation box by the entrance. We will hold this information securely and will destroy it after 21 days.
