## Weekly Pew Sheet (6th to 12th December)

Places of worship are now permitted to reopen for public worship. Services at Holy Trinity will resume from 6th December. All are welcome to attend in person.

**IMPORTANT: From 6th December, the weekly pew sheet and parish magazine will no longer be sent in the post. Both will be available to collect on a Sunday morning when we gather for the Eucharist in future. If you are shielding or unable to physically attend, you can request the pew sheet is sent in the post.**

- In line with government guidance, all visitors (unless exempt) must wear face coverings during worship or while visiting for private prayer and sightseeing.
- There are hand sanitiser points for public use at the entry and exit – please do make use of these as you enter and leave the church.
- NHS Test and Trace: Holy Trinity has now been asked to take your contact details when you attend for worship. This will only be used if there is a need to contact you due to the Test & Trace programme. Consent forms are available at the entrance and can be deposited in the donation box by the entrance. We will hold this information securely and will destroy it after 21 days.
