Weekly Pew Sheet (20th to 24th December)

From 9th December, the church building will be open daily (where possible) from 10.00 am to 3.00 pm for private prayer and sightseeing.

Public worship has also resumed with people able to attend in person at 11.00 am on Sundays or 12.15 pm on Wednesdays. Our Sunday service at 11.00 am will no longer be broadcast online or by telephone – all are encouraged to begin returning to church. The church building is COVID safe following Government guidelines. All other services continue to be offered in person, online or by telephone. For the time being, the 7.00 pm Compline service remains online and by telephone only.

REMINDER: The pew sheet and parish magazine are no longer sent in the post. Both are available to collect on a Sunday morning when we gather for worship.

- In line with government guidance, all visitors (unless exempt) must wear face coverings during worship or while visiting for private prayer and sightseeing.
- There are hand sanitiser points for public use at the entry and exit – please do make use of these as you enter and leave the church.
- NHS Test and Trace: Holy Trinity has now been asked to take your contact details when you attend for worship. This will only be used if there is a need to contact you due to the Test & Trace programme. Consent forms are available at the entrance and can be deposited in the donation box by the entrance. We will hold this information securely and will destroy it after 21 days.
