Happy New Year from us all at Holy Trinity

Announcement following York moving into Tier 3

In line with the Government's new measures to control the pandemic, Holy Trinity is amending timings for private prayer. The church will remain open for public worship and private prayer. **However, the building will be closed for sightseeing until further notice.**

The new timings for private prayer are 12noon to 3.00 pm on Sundays and 12noon to 3.00 pm Wednesdays. The times for public worship (11.00 am Sunday and 12.15 pm Wednesday) remain unchanged.

- In line with government guidance, all visitors (unless exempt) must wear face coverings during worship or while visiting for worship and private prayer.
- There are hand sanitiser points for public use at the entry and exit – please do make use of these as you enter and leave the church.
- NHS Test and Trace: Holy Trinity has now been asked to take your contact details when you attend for worship. This will only be used if there is a need to contact you due to the Test & Trace programme. Consent forms are available at the entrance and can be deposited in the donation box by the entrance. We will hold this information securely and will destroy it after 21 days.
